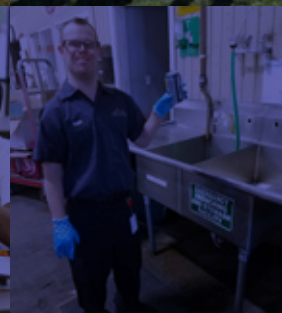
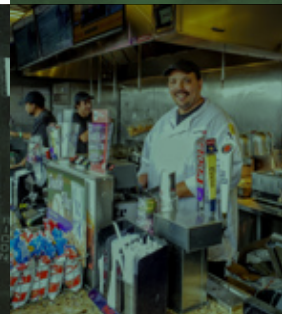

In addition to helping Dennis find a fulfilling job, Laradon also worked to get Dennis in a nourishing and supportive Host Home as part of our **Community Living program**. When he's not at home or work, you'll likely find Dennis on Laradon's campus or out in the community as part of the **Adult Day program**.

“Laradon has given me a place to call home after all these wonderful years,” Dennis said.

Dennis' passion has turned him into an advocate for himself and others with intellectual and developmental disabilities as part of the Laradon Officers group. His self-advocacy and desire to give back also led him to fulfilling a longtime goal of joining the **Laradon Foundation Board of Directors**. He is currently an honorary board member and the first differently-abled representative.

While much has changed since Dennis first arrived, Laradon remains steadfast in our commitment to empower each person we serve to reach their goals and embrace possibility.

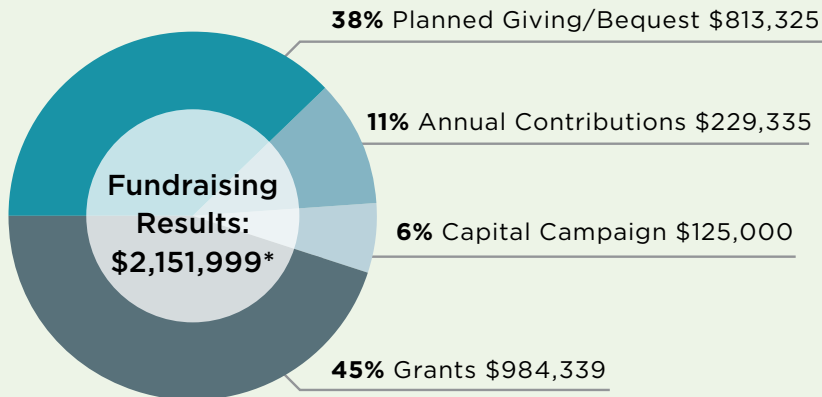

Fundraising Results

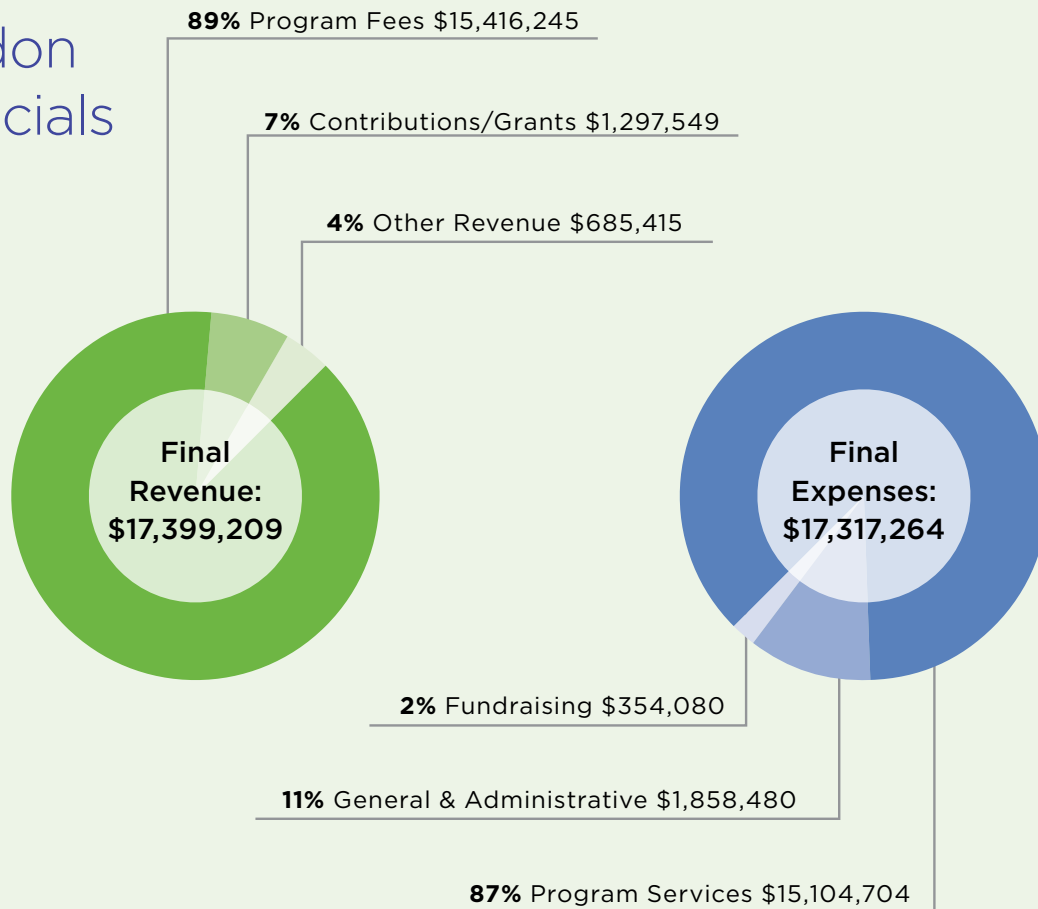
